II. General information

1. The responsible person within the meaning of the General Data Protection Regulation and other national data protection laws of the member states as well as other data protection provisions is QIAGEN Gdańsk Sp. z o.o. formerly BLIRT S.A., with its seat in Gdańsk, 3/2.58 Trzy Lipy Street, 80-172 Gdańsk, entered into the Register of Entrepreneurs maintained by the District Court Północ – Gdańsk in Gdańsk, VII Commercial Division of the National Court Register, under the No. 0001053182.

2. This Privacy Policy covers our treatment of personal information under applicable data protection and privacy laws, including but not limited to (1)) personal data, as defined by the European Union General Data Protection Regulation (the "GDPR") (2) personally identifiable information, as defined by numerous statutes in the United States, including the California Online Privacy Protection Act (such statutes, the "PII Laws") (3) personal information, as defined by the California Consumer Privacy Act (the "CCPA") and for this purpose applies solely to visitors, users, and others who reside in the State of California, (4) personal data, as defined by the General Law on Personal Data Protection of Brazil (referred in Brazil as Lei Geral de Proteção de Dados – LGPD)

3. Personal data collected by the Provider of the Online Shop is processed pursuant to the provisions of the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the (EU) Council 2016/679 of 27/04/2016 on the protection of natural persons as regards personal data processing, on the free movement of such data and on the repeal of Directive 95/46/EC



(General Data Protection Regulation) (Official Journal of the EU L 119, pg. 1) hereinafter referred to as: GDPR.

4. The Provider of the Online Shop does the utmost to protect privacy and information shared with him and related to Customers of the Online Shop. The Administrator exercises due diligence to choose and apply proper technical measures, including ones of programming and unauthorized character, to ensure the protection of data; he especially secures data against sharing with unauthorized people, disclosure, loss, damage, unauthorized modification, and processing in breach of applicable legal provisions.

5. Target customers of Products and Services available on the website are not children under 16 years of age. The Controller of personal data does not provide for intentional acquisition of data related to children under 16 years of age.

III. Purposes of processing personal data

The person responsible for personal data processes your personal data for the following purposes and to this extent:

- We generally only collect and use personal data from our users to the extent that this is necessary to provide a functional website and our content and services.
- If you use our online shop offer, we process your personal data for forwarding to our affiliate QIAGEN GmbH, QIAGEN Strasse 1, 40724 Hilden, Germany, which processes your purchase request.
- When you use our contact form, we will forward your request, including the personal data you have provided, to our affiliate QIAGEN GmbH, QIAGEN Strasse 1, 40724 Hilden, Germany, which will process your request.

IV. Categories of relevant personal data

The Controller of personal data processes the following categories of relevant personal data:

- contact information like name, company, email address;
- Information relating to your purchases and purchase inquiries;
- information related to your complaints, claims, and requests.

V. Legal basis for data processing

The processing of personal data that is required to fulfill a contract of which you (or the legal entity you are working for) are a party, Art. 6 para. 1 lit. b) GDPR as a legal basis. This also applies to processing operations required to carry out pre-contractual actions. Insofar as the processing of personal data is required to fulfill a legal obligation to which QIAGEN GMBH is subject, Art. 6 para. 1 lit. c) GDPR is the legal basis for such processing.

If the processing of personal data is necessary to safeguard the legitimate interests of QIAGEN GMBH, Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f) GDPR serves as a legal basis.



If a transfer of personal data to other companies of the QIAGEN Group based in a third country takes place, the transfer is based on the standard contractual clauses pursuant to Art. 46 para. 2 lit. c) GDPR and appropriate supplementary security measures.

VI. Data processing time

1. Personal data are processed for as long as they are necessary for the execution of orders, the provision of services and other services provided on behalf of the customer. QIAGEN Gdańsk Sp. z o.o. formerly BLIRT S.A. itself does not collect or process any personal data from users of our contact form for inquiries and purchase inquiries. X. Rights of the data subject

If your personal data is processed, you are the data subject within the meaning of the GDPR and you are entitled to the rights described below. In principle, please direct your



request to the Data Protection Officer.

1. Information

You have the right to receive free information about your personal data processed by us at any time as well as confirmation of storing your personal information and a copy of this data.

2. Correction

You have the right to rectification and / or completion if the personal data we hold on you is incorrect or incomplete.

3. Restriction of processing

You have the right to request the restriction of processing, under certain conditions

4. Deletion

You have the right to have your personal data deleted without delay, under certain conditions.

5. Data portability

You have the right to receive personally identifiable information you provided to us in a structured, common and machine-readable format. You also have the right to transfer this data to another person without hindrance. In exercising this right, you also have the right to obtain that personal data relating to you are transmitted directly by us to another person responsible, insofar as this is technically feasible. Freedoms and rights of other persons may not be affected.

6. Objection

You have the right to object at any time to the processing of personal data relating to you which is "only" based on legitimate interests of us or third parties (Article 6 (1) (f) GDPR). In the event of an objection, we will no longer process personal data unless we can demonstrate compelling legitimate reasons for processing that outweigh your interests, rights and freedoms, or the processing is for the purpose of asserting, exercising or defending legal claims.

7. Revocation of consent

You have the right to revoke your consent to the processing activities, if previously collected, at any time. The revocation of consent does not affect the legality of the processing carried out on the basis of the consent until the revocation.

8. Right to complain to a supervisory authority

Without prejudice to any other administrative or judicial remedy, you shall have the right to complain to a supervisory authority, in particular in the member state of your residence, place of work, or place of alleged infringement, if you believe that the processing of the personal data concerning you violates the GDPR.
